I've heard it said, "Missionaries are not on the front lines but behind enemy lines." I was recently told that a friend of mine with two others were sharing the Gospel in a town up north when the entire town took up stones to kill the three, and by the grace of God, they ran as fast as they could and escaped with their lives. We fully trust our lives with the One who called us here.

Please pray for us as we endeavor to plant Gospel-preaching churches in a nation of 126+ million people where there are so incredibly few.
