An Update From The Kidd Family

Dear Friends and Co-Laborers in Christ,

The summer months passed quickly and in mid-August we put Carissa on a plane to send her back to the US to continue her studies at PCC. She is a Sophomore Elementary Education major and a Business minor. Please continue to pray with us as our desire is to open a Christian school here using the aBeka curriculum after she graduates. A school offering an education in English is a huge open door to minister to many homes that we would not otherwise have opportunity. If anyone is interested in learning more about this great ministry opportunity, please reach out to us.

Praise the Lord, we were able to get Pastor Edson Silva and his family moved to the northern island of São Vicente to continue the work in Mindelo at Templo Baptista. They have many challenges ahead of them, but with God by their side, nothing is impossible. They have already seen some blessings in the short time they have been there. Please continue praying for them as they adjust to life on a different island and the work of the ministry there.

We had a great, albeit very short, visit from Brother Phillip Pritchard (Director of PREACH) and Brother Mike Kennon with Operation Renewed Hope. We are planning a medical mission for January of 2025. We were able to meet again with the director of the Ministry of Health and work further toward obtaining a protocol agreement with them. We scouted out some potential clinic sites and searched for a place to rent large tents, tables and chairs. I believe we made some good progress. Please pray that the preparations would continue and that we would be able to reach multitudes with the Gospel through this.

The end of summer brings the rainy season which lasts for about 2 months. We really do not have different seasons here. There is Hot, Hotter, about 15 days of rain during 2 months, and then Not Quite So Hot. Anyway, with the rain brings more mosquitos. This year there has been quite the outbreak of Dengue Fever. There are several within the churches who have been affected by this. Our family has also been affected. It typically lasts 1-2 weeks and the symptoms vary in severity from person to person. Each time a person gets Dengue, the symptoms are worse than the previous time. Sarah was hit the hardest with 101-103 fevers and no strength/energy for a little over a week and now it seems to have hit Jenny. Thankfully the rest of us had mild symptoms that passed within 1-2 days. Please pray for the people here and us in this regard.

As always, and I cannot say it enough, thank you for your prayers on behalf of us and God's work here in Cape Verde, Africa.
