Upon returning to our area, Karine never found a good church and struggled for years in her Christian walk. Fast forward now to this past September when she showed up on a Sunday morning and has since come every Sunday. Please pray for Karine's spiritual growth and for her unsaved daughter, Juliette.

Annie Hénaux is a quiet lady from the neighborhood who has been attending our services. She had lived for years with a troubled marriage and a troubled mind, spending a significant amount of time with psychiatrists. However, Annie was walking toward her apartment near the church this past fall when she was attacked in broad daylight and robbed. This terrible episode led her to retreat into herself and to cut off contact with almost everyone, except her children. This went on for many months. In the spring of this year, I invited her to our Easter service, not really expecting her to answer—and what a surprise it was when she said she would come! Annie told us that she had trusted Christ as her Savior right before the mugging, but

didn't end up confiding in us until she came back to church. She has made a huge transformation. She has so much peace and is growing in her walk. Lincoln and I have been discipling her, and she recently made a public profession of her faith through baptism.

Over the past few months, spiritual warfare has never been more obvious to us as missionaries. We have a real enemy who is constantly at work.
